

Grant Agreement

This **Grant Agreement** is entered into November 2022 (the “**Effective Date**”) by and between:

- 1- **SMALLWORLD FOUNDATION**, a charity registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales, having registration number 1174733 (“**SmallWorld**”); and
- 2- Child Rights And You UK, a charity registered in 2007, holding registration no. 1119026 (“**CRY UK**”).

(SmallWorld and CRY UK will be referred to individually as a “**Party**” and collectively as the “**Parties**”)

PREAMBLE

Whereas SmallWorld’s objects include advancing human rights and promoting equality by advocating for the interests and concerns of civil society, in particular economically and socially disadvantaged children, and defending their fundamental human right to health and education.

Whereas CRY UK is a charity registered with charity number 1119026 under the Charities Act 2011 in the United Kingdom (“**UK**”) which raises and mobilises funds to support child development and rights related projects in the UK and particularly to India.

Whereas, the Parties wish to collaborate together in relation to the project further detailed below (the “**Project**”):

<u>Location:</u>	Mitauli block - Lakhimpur Kheri district

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the promises and the mutual covenants hereinafter, the Parties have agreed as follows:



1. Purpose

The purpose of the project is to support disadvantaged and underprivileged children (i) located in India; (ii) aged between 11-18; and (iii) (the “**Beneficiaries**”), by providing child-friendly teaching techniques and workshops to ensure access to uninterrupted schooling and minimize the risk of dropping out of school.

- 1.1 SmallWorld has approached its contacts, network and connections (the “**Donors**”) for the purposes of securing monetary charitable contributions, awards, grants, donations and otherwise for the Project (the “**Contributions**”). The Contributions will be paid by SmallWorld UK account to CRY UK, strictly for the purpose of the project.
- 1.2 The contributions will be on behalf of SmallWorld. CRY UK agrees to provide SmallWorld with an expenditure budget for the Contributions.
- 1.3 SmallWorld will grant a total sum of £5,000.
- 1.4 Upon receipt of the Contributions, CRY UK must ensure that they are paid towards and allotted strictly for the Beneficiaries and the Project.
- 1.5 The Project is dedicated towards creating fun and safe spaces to play and learn as well as reconnect with education, with necessary confidence. The project will include life skill sessions, online learning, trauma counselling, awareness on education, in addition to sports, theater and art-based activities. Parental group sessions will also take place to build knowledge around issues related to children.
- 1.6 Each of the Beneficiaries will be able to develop Increased self-confidence, positive thinking, understanding of emotions, and better verbal communication and life skills.
- 1.7 The Project is expected to be for a term of ONE (1) years (the “**Term**”).
- 1.8 The Project has been personalized to benefit the beneficiaries with utmost utilization of the donations.
- 1.9 The project endorses a transformation perspective by encouraging and working with vulnerable children to support them and their caregivers by creating fun and safe spaces to play and learn as well as reconnect with education, with necessary confidence. The project will include life skill sessions, online learning, trauma counselling, awareness on education, in addition to sports, theater and art-based activities. Parental group sessions will also take place to build knowledge around issues related to children.



- 1.10** The Children will benefit from up to 4 hours over approximately 20 sessions a month, during the course of the agreement.
- 1.11** The grant is going to support 1 Children and Adolescent Resource Centre starting December 2022.
- 1.12** The Contributions collected from the Donors are expected to include the cost necessary for the actual sessions, in addition to the trainings and resources such as the material used.
- 1.13** SmallWorld will raise awareness and funds for the “Children and Adolescent Resource Centre” CARC program.
- 1.14** CRY UK will provide all the information in regards to the number of children supported by the project, and the number of staff and parents trained.
- 1.15** CRY UK will provide the necessary financial information on where the funds must be deposited, delivered or transferred by SmallWorld .
- 1.16** Beneficiaries: As per the list received by us from CRY UK, the list of the beneficiaries are of Ages of 11 – 18.
- 1.17** In consideration for receiving the Contributions, CRY UK must perform the following:
 - A) Throughout the Term, CRY UK must provide SmallWorld a (i) annual report to update and inform SmallWorld of the progress and status of the Project; and (ii) formal report at the end of the Project summarizing the lessons learned and how the Beneficiaries benefited from the Project; and
 - B) throughout the Term, and on a regular basis, provide SmallWorld with pictures, photos and videos which SmallWorld may use on its website, social media pages, and elsewhere. This evidence will not contain images of children due to safeguarding restrictions in terms of providing consent.
- 1.18** SmallWorld may at any reasonable time, by providing CRY UK four (4) week’s prior notice, visit the center and interact with the Beneficiaries.
